3. Jesus is condemned by the Sanhedrin
4. Jesus is denied by Peter
5. Jesus is judged by Pontius Pilate
6. Jesus is scourged at the pillar and crowned with thorns -reserved
7. Jesus bears the cross -reserved
8. Jesus is helped by Simon the Cyrenian to carry the cross -reserved
9. Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem -reserved
10. Jesus is crucified -reserved
11. Jesus promises his Kingdom to the repentant thief
12. Jesus speaks to his mother and the Beloved Disciple -reserved
13. Jesus dies on the cross -reserved
14. Jesus is placed in the tomb -reserved
