**A free Soup luncheon** will be held on Sunday, March 5th after worship and Sunday school. This is being offered as part of Avery Smith's Senior Project.



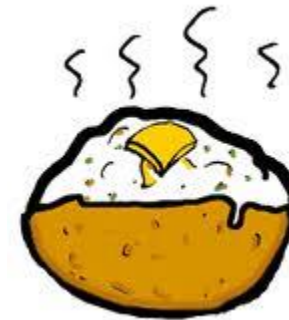
