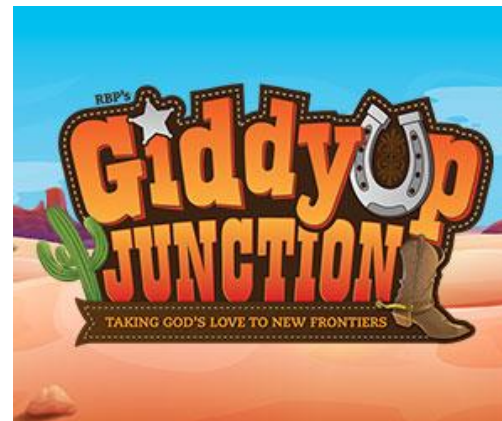
Uniting in Prayer: Proclaim Christ Reclaim Passion
