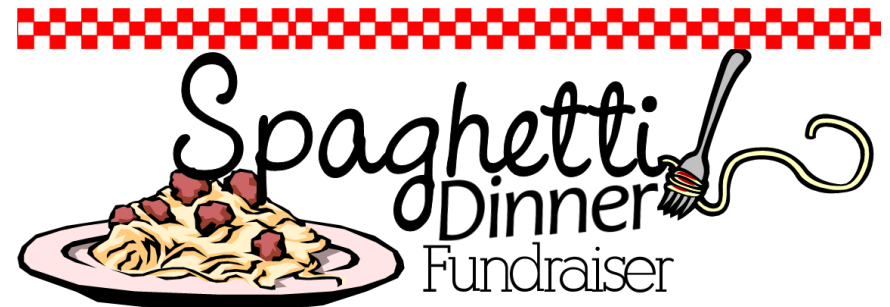
**A Deacon Calling** will be held in October. Please begin to prayerfully consider who in our congregation could be called to fill this role. More information in future bulletins and October Newsletter.
