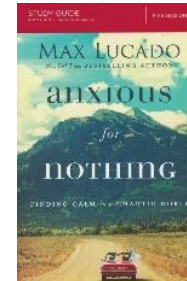
Genesis Class is starting a new book study on October 4th during Sunday School. The book is *Anxious for Nothing* by Max Lucado.

Directions to Over's Cottage
Big Bend Beach

1. From Roaring Spring or Huntingdon

- From the intersection of Route 36 (Woodbury Pike) and Route 26 (Raystown Road) proceed south on Route 26 (Raystown Road) 2.5 miles to the Kountry Kettle Restaurant (which is on the right)
- Turn slight left onto Colonel John Drive and proceed 0.2 miles to West Cypher Road
- Bear left after the STOP onto West Cypher Road and proceed 1.4 miles to Plank Road
- Turn hard right onto Plank Road and proceed 1.7 miles to the Bethel Church of the Brethren (on the left)
- Turn left onto Brailer Station Road and proceed 0.7 miles through the stone arch underpass to Big Bend Beach Road
- Turn left after the STOP onto Big Bend Beach Road and proceed 1.4 miles to the 2nd. PRIVATE DRIVE (Pie Avenue) on the left (somewhat hidden at the bottom of the hill). We used to be the only drive and one was added immediately before our drive.
- Turn left onto Pie Avenue through the yellow gate
- Proceed on Pie Avenue to the last cottage on the left which is **HO-OVER INN**

2. From Breezewood or Everett

- Take Route 30 to Route 26 North (Raystown Road)
- Proceed north 2.0+/- miles to the Brite Spot Sub Shop (on the right)
- Turn right onto Plank Road and proceed 0.4 miles to Ritchey Bridge Road
- Bear right after STOP onto Ritchey Bridge Road and proceed 1.1 miles to Brailer Station Road
- Turn left onto Brailer Station Road and proceed 0.9 miles through "T" intersection onto Big Bend Beach Road and then proceed 1.4 miles to the 2nd. PRIVATE DRIVE (Pie Avenue)(somewhat hidden at the bottom of the hill). We used to be the only drive and one was added immediately before our drive.
- Turn left onto Pie Avenue (through yellow gate)
- Proceed on Pie Avenue to the last cottage on the left which is **HO-OVER INN**
- **P.S. From any direction if you cross the river you have made a mistake!**
